Hanna Simon received her advanced education in political studies in France and later on was appointed as the first ambassador of the newly established State of Eritrea to France and the European Institutions in the late 1990s. She was also among the first participants in the EUCLID University program when it was approved by Minister of Foreign Affairs

Osman Saleh for the Government of Eritrea in 2008. She completed her Master in Diplomacy and International Affairs in 2011 and was invited to join the faculty to teach course DIP-607 “Diplomatic Protocol and Immunities” for which she has extraordinary first hand knowledge and experience.

- The Palestinian Issue: A thorny case at the United Nations (presented to the Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Senegal in 2010).
